

# SOURCE CLASSES

## 1. "Introduction to the New Testament" (20 credits)

As a companion module to 'Introducing the Old Testament', this is also designed to ensure that you have a thorough grounding in the entire NT. How trustworthy is John's portrayal of Jesus, given that he describes Jesus as never using parables, has him talking in long abstract meditations and cleansing the temple at the beginning of his ministry, not the end? Does the book of Acts provide a model for the way the contemporary church should operate? Should we think of Paul as an evangelist or as a theologian? Why do Paul and James apparently come to totally different conclusions on the nature of faith? Were the Pharisees really that bad?

No matter the level of experience in the NT you feel you already have, this module will almost certainly provide valuable information and insights. It is an ideal stand-alone study, or excellent preparation for moving deeper into biblical study.

This module will run from the beginning of February till the end of March 2008, 7pm – 9:30pm with a coffee break half way through. The cost is £120 for personal development attendees and £180 for theology students.

## 2. Counselling Certificate (Accredited through OCN & Christian Guidelines)

An introduction to the knowledge, skills & attitudes framework for counselling covering: Biblical Basis & Theory, Counselling Skills, Human Development, Relationships, Specific Applications, Principles & Procedures.
